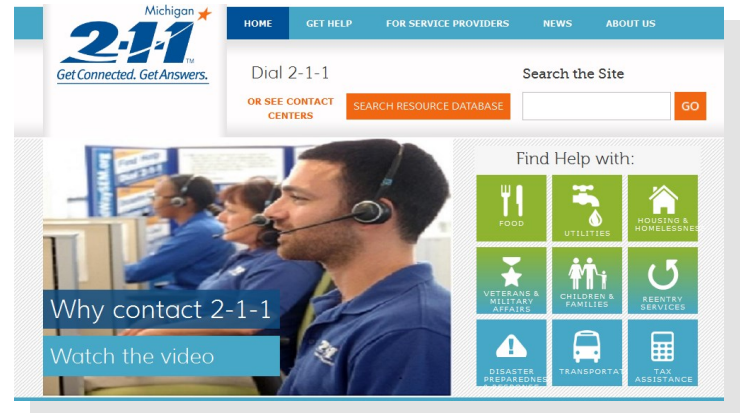


# Connect with 2-1-1 Online!

Through [www.MI211.org](http://www.MI211.org), you can access information about all of the programs and services that 2-1-1 has available through your fingertips!

- The new website uses the same information that is available to the 2-1-1 call specialists.

**Service description:** Distributes food to people who are in emergency situations.

**Eligibility:** Service is limited to once every 30 days. Must live in the service area of the food pantry. 2-1-1 can assist with determining which food pantry using the home address.

**Application process:** Walk-ins accepted.

**Documents required:** Valid Michigan ID, Proof of residence, Social Security Numbers for all family members, Birth dates for all family members.

**Fees:** No fees.

**Payment method:** Not applicable.

**Area served:** Northeast corner of Battle Creek. Call 2-1-1 for assistance on determining the correct Neighborhood Food Pantry.

**Service hours:** Mon-Fri 9am-11:45am

Site may be closed due to weather when both Battle Creek Public Schools and Pennfield Schools close. Site is generally closed on holidays and the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years.

**Services:** Food Pantries

**Site area served:** The northeast corner of Battle Creek.

**Site hours:** Mon-Fri 9am-12pm

**Location:** Located within the Maple United Methodist Church. The Food and Baby Pantry is located in the lower level of the church. Use the door off the alley parking lot.
